

New leadership at Beckwith Park

NURIOOTPA'S Beckwith Park has a new chief executive.

Jeremy Blanks, an Adelaide commercial property developer, has been appointed to lead the industry and business initiative.

With more than 15 years in property development, Mr Blanks brings a lot of experience to the role.

"I'm a huge believer in this project," Jeremy said.

"It's the only park of its size and scale in country South Australia and is right in the middle of one of the fastest growing regional centres in Australia."
